CLICK REGISTER

CLICK **"RETURNING USER"** (DO NOT CLICK **"NEW USER"**)

THIS OPENS A NEW PAGE: FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, DATE OF BIRTH (USE THE NAME ON YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD)

CLICK SEARCH

THIS OPENS A NEW PAGE: EMAIL, PASSWORD (10 CHARACTERS, AT LEAST ONE CAPITAL AND ONE LOWER CASE)

NOTE: (ONE DIFFERENT EMAIL ADDRESS PER EACH MEMBER)

CLICK UPDATE

CHECK YOUR EMAIL SUBJECT "CONFIRM REGISTRATION" OPEN (if not there, check spam folder)

CLICK "CONFIRM EMAIL". THIS WILL REDIRECT YOU BACK TO THE CPS-ECP HOME PAGE

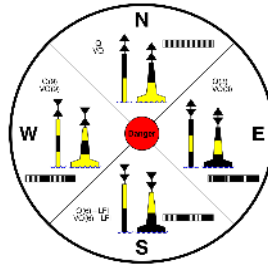
YOU MAY NOW "LOG IN" WITH YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS AND NEW PASSWORD
