### REGISTER AND RECLAIM PROFILE

CLICK REGISTER

CLICK “RETURNING USER” (DO NOT CLICK “NEW USER”)

THIS OPENS A NEW PAGE: FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, DATE OF BIRTH (USE THE NAME ON YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD)

CLICK SEARCH

THIS OPENS A NEW PAGE: EMAIL, PASSWORD (10 CHARACTERS, AT LEAST ONE CAPITAL AND ONE LOWER CASE)

NOTE: (ONE DIFFERENT EMAIL ADDRESS PER EACH MEMBER)

CLICK UPDATE

NOTICE APPEARS: “THANK YOU FOR SIGNING UP” “YOU HAVE BEEN SENT A COFIRMATION EMAIL”

CHECK YOUR EMAIL

CLICK “CONFIRM EMAIL”. THIS WILL REDIRECT YOU BACK TO THE CPS-ECP HOME PAGE

YOU MAY NOW “LOG IN” WITH YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS AND NEW PASSWORD

AFTER LOGING IN, YOU WILL SEE YOUR NAME IN THE TOP RIGHT CORNER. MOVE THE CURSOR TO YOUR NAME, DROP DOWN SCREEN APPEARS. 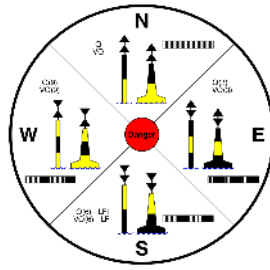
